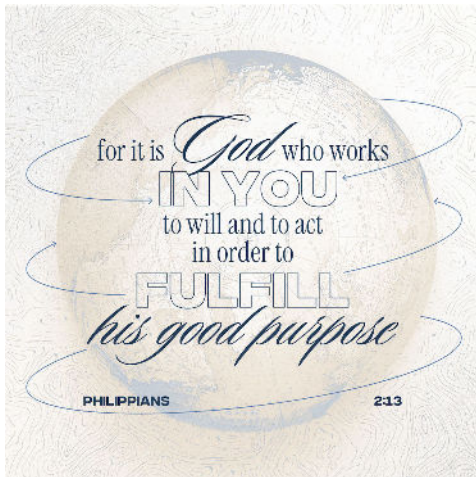


GRUMBLY GRATEFUL or GREATFULLY HUMBLE
